Welcome everyone!

Agenda – Discuss parking concerns that we have around the school. Unfortunately By-law officer Mike Cane was unable to make it to the meeting because of a family emergency. Our traffic liaison for SD23, Dave Gibson, was able to attend.

-We all have concerns about getting our children to and from school safely. Parking in the area is a challenge. By-law has one traffic enforcement person, and they are aware of the challenges that we face and they are open to working with us to help to try and alleviate some of the more problematic issues.

-By-law has now committed to a drive-by pilot project around SLE. They will take pictures and then ticket those individuals breaking the rules. By-law wants the feedback from the neighbourhood, so keep calling and sending in our concerns.

- Some suggestions to put forward for by-law/ city council
 - -a rotation program for by-law to visit all the schools in the area.
 - -have no parking on one side of the street.
 - -bushes that block sightlines need to be addressed.
 - -propose to city council to restrict parking between 8-9am and 2-3pm.
 - -expand the parking lot by the tennis courts and have angled parking there.
 - have a one way couplet through Sandstone Dr. and Sandstone Cres.
 - -have a flashing pedestrian light installed at the crosswalk.
- -Some other options from a school perspective
- -to utilize the walking school bus theory to drop off kids in the community and have a five minute walk to school.
 - -school pool organize a car pool in your neighborhood.

-Safe Routes to School program is a regional program to help the schools get sidewalks in the area. Have a group walk about the school area, and identify barriers that are dangerous and talk about solutions for the area.

-Have the safe walk to school program come to the school.

- Kiss and Ride rules need to be followed. The rules and regulations can be found on the school website under programs and services.
