 - o PAC -infrastructure
 - District Playground

- Now it's a formal process
 - o 1st is safety standards (heights of equipment/jump/fall)
 - We are on the list and are hopeful that we will get funding and should know in a few weeks of decision which school was chosen
- Need a solid design that will be evaluated on 8 criteria
 - Some of the decisions will need to balance btwn value and active/engagement/inclusivity etc.
 - o All vendors will build to a budget
- There are three lines of grading the bids
 - Local
 - Materials used
 - Activities offered
- There is a system with what the board wants to see
- We need to outline the overall site for scope of work

Steve from Habitat Playgrounds

- Steve provided a PowerPoint presentation
- Discussions were on how he can help us navigate the waters of playground design
