Principal's Report

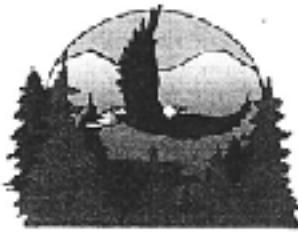
