## Principal's Report to PAC ~ September 9, 2013

# **Shannon Lake Elementary School**

A warm welcome back to all parents and a special welcome to any parents new to SLE!

I'm happy to report that as of today we have registered 507 students at SLE in 21 classrooms. 84 of these students are new Kindergartens who had their first half day today, another tomorrow, and their first full day on Wednesday. This year those little people will have the playground to themselves at lunchtime each day: they will eat when we play and play when we eat! They will also have their own afternoon recess time from 1:10 – 1:25 pm each day. Any parent volunteers willing to come from 11:15-12:00 until we get ourselves established are most welcome!!

Kiss and Ride is up and running with just a few slots open for volunteers – schedule here and in the office for sign up. There have been parent concerns from Shannon Woods re: bus travel this year – also a request from Tallus Ridge for a car pool for an ill parent. A general reminder as well that criminal record checks need to be completed by September 30th. Forms are in the office and the school district pays all costs.

Kristine Vodarek is already establishing our Parent Ambassadors Program to facilitate communication from the PAC and the school directly to each classroom. Please see her for sign up, with my sincere appreciation. A message from our Ambassadors: \$40 school fees cover all school supplies at SLE as well as our cultural performances. We shop in bulk for what the teachers request, and it's a great deal for parents!



Looking forward to the PAC Welcome Back Barbeque and would request the possibility of a 20th Birthday Cake there for SLE J.

Other important dates include School Photos on Sep 23, and the Terry Fox Run on Sep 26 – another occasion where we depend on volunteers along the route – please see Mr. Bruce or me tonight if you can be there at 1:00 pm Freezies from PAC would also be a gift! J

October 2 there will be another Open House in our gym hosted by the DWK to continue the planning for traffic calming in our school area – you can see it's coming up the hill towards us now that the corner at Shannon Lake Road and Shannon Way is nearly done.

Of great importance to us all is the construction of Mar Jok, the new elementary school being built in the Rose Valley/Shannon Lake catchment and expected to open for September 2014. Initial consultation with us began in June and our director, Dr. Rick Oliver will host a second session with us on October 1 from 6-8 pm at SLE. I'll keep you posted, but there has been nothing definite yet regarding any changes in catchment areas or processes for redirecting families to the new school. This is all yet to be decided. All new currently out-of-catchment families were given a letter at registration this year stating that they were accepted at SLE for this year.

As we look at fundraising for the year ahead let me take this opportunity to thank you so much for the hours of time, energy and commitment you give to this learning community!
